

DAFFODILS

In mid to late February (and for 30 days or so) Safeway offers what they call "dry cut" daffodils. They are (should be) sold out of water, usually in bundles of 10 for less than \$2.00! They are tightly budded, not blooming and need to be freshly cut and put in water. Within 2 days they open up to a beautiful, long lasting flower good for 10-14 days.

If you call Safeway ahead of time the flower department will pre order and hold for you. Just make sure that they leave them in cold storage and do not put them in water for your pick up.
